CITY CLERK	Lori Collins (847) 596 - 8680	The City Clerk is the official bookkeeper that keeps track of records, accounts, and other administrative duties. The city clerk has a 4-year term.
TREASURER	Vance D. Wyatt (847) 596 – 8628	Treasurer is a person that administers or manages financial assets and liabilities. The treasurer has a 4-year-term
ALDERMAN	Find your alderman at northchicago.org	Aldermen make up the elected body and make decisions for their local government. The alderman has a 4-year term.

What are property taxes?

The tax is usually based on the value of the owned property, including the land.


